Tom Burr, a long time resident of Castle Cary and of Somerset, decided on his career on a picnic at Stourhead aged 14, and joined The National Trust on April Fool's Day 1963 remaining with them until his retirement some 38 years later. In 1976, he moved to Somerset as Officer for the Wessex Region based at Stourhead and was involved amongst other things, with the fêtes champêtre, enjoyed by so many. He was awarded the MBE "for services to conservation" in the Millennium Honours List.

This year, Tom has kindly agreed to give us a talk on "Stourhead, The Creation of the Landscape" - the contribution each generation has made to the landscape, and the 100 year plan. This will be a great opportunity to learn more about the gardens and ask those questions you've always wanted to ask about its history and conservation issues involved in the maintenance of the landscape.
